I would kindly inform you that following the signature of the new Grant Agreement the text of the new <u>acknowledgement</u> has become available:

This work has been carried out within the framework of the EUROfusion Consortium, funded by the European Union via the Euratom Research and Training Programme (Grant Agreement No 101052200 — EUROfusion). Views and opinions expressed are however those of the author(s) only and do not necessarily reflect those of the European Union or the European Commission. Neither the European Union nor the European Commission can be held responsible for them.

<u>The EUROfusion poster and oral presentation templates</u> have been updated to include the new acknowledgement. You can find all relevant information on the <u>user's site</u>. Please be kindly reminded, that according to the <u>GRANT AGREEMENT (Project 101052200 —EUROfusion)</u> the publication requirements regarding peer reviewed papers have been considerably changed. The most relevant changes are:

- Immediate open access should be provided for a machine-readable electronic copy of the published version or for the final peer-reviewed manuscript accepted for publication.
- Only publication fees in full open access venues for peer-reviewed scientific publications are eligible for reimbursement.

In order to allow a smooth transition, for papers resulting from work partially or fully performed during FP8, the FP8 publication rules apply namely: page or open access charges will be payed centrally by PMU and open access will be provided in line with the rules of the publishers. Please ask the authors to make sure that both FP8 and the FP9 work packages are selected on the pinboard.

For papers solely resulting from work funded by FP9, a case by case approach should be followed. Please ask the authors of such papers to contact both the library of their institution and Kinga Gal.
