- We think the structure and focus has improved across all WPs even if we are not yet there overall -> however, we have to concede the extremly short notices from our side and thank for the effort
 done on all sides ==> we need to improve the timings next year and should keep a "main editor" as
 suggested by STAC and in the AWP 2025 meeting.
- PLs/TFLs to review work in their work package and identify work that did not take place in 2024 by mid November to release the associated resources and request Budget control to move them to 2025

- As discussed in the AWP:
 - Internally started the drafting of a MOU for Collaboration in Fusion Research and Development for mutual benefit and reciprocity --> Coordinators to reach out to PL/TFLs -> at this stage defining for headlines
 - PSD wants to collect a list of activities that relate to ITER inside PSD that map towards the ITER research plan by November 30th:
 - Step 1: Collect modelling for/of ITER across WPs
 - Step 2: Experiments and analysis from 2025 once TE programme is defined deadline tbd



TE Enhancements & DB & Stellarator Reactor

- PSD/PMU will prepare a survey to be done every 4 months regarding the status of the TE enhancement projects with the aim to follow the overall progress, monitor risks in human resources availability and hardwear costs with impact on depreciation (likely similar scheme to the administrative monitoring of TSVVs)
- PSD would like to understand the status of the release of the databases following the discussions at the AWP2025 we are aware that once set up
- A proposal to derive a document defining the physics gaps towards a Stellarator Reactor by the end of 2025 has been drafted --> PSD is proposing to the PB the allocation of participation resources as discussed at the AWP2025 meeting
