## AUG

- Shutdown - WPTE experiments expected to be restarted in April 2026

## TCV

- In operation. BUT issues with IT. Operation cancelled at the end of last week. Delays in NBI-2 repair announced: not before summer

## MAST-U

- MU05 resumed – NBI: both SS and SW at ~68kV. Lower divertor cryopump is unavailable due to a helium leak

## WEST

- Shutdown - C13 planned to start at the end of April 2026

## JET

- In shutdown/decommissioning
